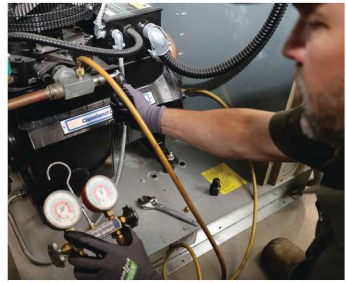




REFRIGERATION & INSTALLATION BASICS
